Why volunteer?

Whether it is to make new friends, to give back, learn new skills, or just enjoy the rewards of being part of the community, people volunteer with us for many reasons.

Purpose

The Social Group Volunteer's role is to support the running of the London Irish Centre's Social Groups. This involves giving a warm Irish welcome to everyone. You will help ensure a safe and friendly environment where people can connect with others in the community. Our aim is to empower people to live healthy, connected lives.

Role

The Social Group Volunteer works as part of a team to run Social Groups around London.

Key tasks

- Support the setup of the venue for the group to take place.
- Welcome people as they arrive and help them to feel included and settled.
- Check in with people and follow up with staff about any concerns.
- Support with the preparation and serving of refreshments.
- Support the general running of the groups, running small errands, etc.
- Help the clean-up of the venue to be ready for the next group.
- Follow confidentiality and safeguarding procedures (training will be provided)

- Availability to volunteer during the day?
- Ability to commit to support a weekly group?

Time commitment

- Social Groups run on weekday afternoons
- Shift time: 11am-3pm (may vary slightly depending on location)
